

10 year Strategic Vision

The Mission of CAM is to share the love of Christ by providing immediate assistance and encouragement to people in crisis. CAM's focus is to be the emergency room of social services by providing help to individuals with serious systemic issues, one time crisis or those who simply need mercy. Our combination of immediate resources, coupled with a personal interview process and a referral is unique and critical to low income, working poor, mentally/physically ill, and homeless individuals. CAM is also offering hope and the Grace of Jesus Christ. We are a one of a kind nonprofit leveraging \$1 for every dollar raised.

- Raise awareness—Utilizing our highly visible downtown location as a means to promote the
 mission and provide a resource to the community for helping those in need (increasing dollars,
 gaining new supporters, new member churches and improving our services through property
 improvement)
 - 1. McCullough Ave Consortium (working with our local businesses and developers along McCullough as our neighborhood changes and leveraging this opportunity to help those in need)
 - **2.** Change our present exterior and interior of downtown property so that it can continue to serve for 40 years and be a hub for expansion
 - **3.** Create a space that volunteers and donors can access 7 days a week and that is viewed as a community asset to making a difference
- Increased services (more dollars) and bring services to the clients—expanding our reach through satellite or mobile locations throughout the city while increasing what it means to serve (increased dollars for services, Program Coordination) and increased locations through the model of using shared space with a church or nonprofit.
- Recognized experts—Create a reputation that CAM is a voice for those experiencing crisis and is
 working with churches, nonprofits and the community to be a leading expert and a voice for those
 who often don't have one. This would result in increased participation of churches, increased
 partnerships with nonprofits and an overall increased community awareness. More Served.
- Replicable—CAM will become a replicable resource for this type of ministry for churches—sort of a
 "ministry in a box". We will develop a way to share how we operate, help other churches create
 similar helps and have a means to train and provide tangible resources for expansion of services
 where we cannot co-locate. All of this results in more people getting help by leveraging resources,
 dollars and in-kind donations.
