CAM Safety Net Services

- **Groceries** for clients with residence every 30 days
- **Daily Sack Lunches** for homeless clients Monday – Saturday 9:00 am to 11:00 am
- **Clothing** every 30 days to include other things like diapers and wipes when available.
- **Transportation** in the form of **Bus Tickets** to medical appointments, a verifiable job interview or a bus pass to start a new full-time permanent job (must be verified)
- **Limited Financial Assistance for Utilities, ID or BC** once every 12 months
- **Financial Assistance for Prescription Medications** up to \$80.00 every 12 months (this may be given out multiple times a year if each time doesn't total \$80.00)
- **Seasonal help** (when client qualifies) – **School Supplies/Backpacks** (early June), **Coats** from December to February, **Emergency Christmas Help** (early December)
- Downtown location has a **Free Mailbox Service** for Unsheltered Street Homeless Clients
- **Showers** on Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday from 9:30 am – 11:30 am. In partnership with Corazon, Showers are on Tuesday, Thursday, Friday from 1 pm to 3 pm on CAM campus
- **Referrals** to other agencies and help navigating the social service system
- **Specialized Outside Services for Unsheltered Street Homeless** including an every Thursday case management meeting in the CAM Chapel from 9am – 11:30 am (meet with clients in parking lot as early as 7:30 am daily), offer porta potties, food, and emergency help (see page 2)

General Client Requirements to Receive Services

All individuals are welcome at CAM. No appointments necessary, and we have no zip code or demographic restrictions.

- **Photo ID** (of any kind, including a driver's license, school ID, expired ID, etc.)
- **Original Social Security Card** (for all members in the household. If there is an issue, we can offer a grace period on the first visit)
- **Proof of Residency for Groceries** (utility bill [electricity or water] or lease agreement, SSI Award Letter, Food Stamp Notification Letter)
- **Financial Assistance** requires the documents for that need (i.e. disconnect notice, prescription)

2. **Northside Location:** 5084 DeZavala (corner of DeZavala & Vance Jackson) in parking lot of University United Methodist Church. (210) 697-5771 **Hours:** Monday - Thursday 9:00 am – 2 pm

Unsheltered Street Homeless Resource Guide for Downtown San Antonio

CAM opens its gates by 7:30 am; so clients can have access to porta potties. A CAM staff or security person is stationed in the parking lot to answer questions. This list isn't exhaustive but if someone can make it to any of these locations, additional resources and guidance to access shelter can be provided.

Daily Meals/Food

➤ **CAM (Christian Assistance Ministry)**

Location: 110 McCullough, 78215 (near Hwy 281 and Grace Lutheran Church)

Hours/Days: Monday through Saturday, 9 am – 11 am

➤ **Corazon Ministries Day Center**

Location: Next to CAM (110 McCullough) and behind Grace Lutheran church

Hours/Days: Hot Meals Mon-Friday from 12 pm to 1 pm and center is open from 10 am – 4 pm; Corazon operates a breakfast at Travis Park Church on Sunday mornings at 9 am located at 230 East Travis

➤ **Church Under the Bridge (CUB)**

Location: 724 Chestnut St. (off of Nolan St.)

Hours/Days: Hot Meal served daily at 6 pm (7 days a week)

There are multiple food distributions by various churches under the bridge at 281/McCullough on Sundays too

Showers/Hygiene/Underwear/Socks

CAM and Corazon at 110 McCullough offer showers, with hygiene items, underwear and socks provided, 6 days a week on the shared property of CAM and Grace Lutheran Church at 110 McCullough.

- Tuesday, Thursday, Friday 1 pm – 3 pm

General Resources

Including clothing, case management for housing, help to gain access to ID or to get into a shelter, medical support, job training etc.

- **CAM, 110 McCullough**
Services: ID recovery, clothing, shoes, free mailbox, bus tickets for work/medical needs etc.
Hours: Monday through Thursday from 9:30 am – 3 pm & Friday 9:30 – 11:30; ID's and Out of State BC's Wednesday's Only
- **Corazon/Day Center**, next to CAM behind Grace Lutheran Church
Services: Cooling and warming, depending on time of year, onsite case workers and resources
Hours: Monday through Friday from 10:00 am – 4 pm
- **Church Under the Bridge (CUB)**, 724 Chestnut 724 off of Nolan (McCullough turns into Nolan at 281)
Services: Limited clothing, some special resources
Hours: 5:30 pm
- **KRL at First Presbyterian Church**, 404 North Alamo (use the 4th street entrance)
Services: Case management for housing or to get into a shelter, jobs, ID recovery, emergency clothing, food.
Hours: Monday through Friday by appointment and Tuesday and Thursday, walk-ins from 9 am – 11 am
